Chairwoman McCormack called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Aldermanic Chamber of City Hall. Also present were Committee members Paolillo, Lehtonen, DePino and S. Rodriguez.

Chr. McCormack called the appointees in the following order:

Appointment of Marcus Paca (D), 119 Maple Street, to the Development Commission

Mr. Paca told the Committee that he looks forward to teaching from his experience, and learning about development opportunities in New Haven. He added that he hoped to help bring transparency to the Commission.

Appointment of Richard H. Jennings (R), 54 Pond Street, to the Fair Rent Commission

Mr. Jennings said he is a landlord here, and in other states as well. He said he has lived in the Dixwell/Newhallville area since 2002, and has property there. He told the Committee that he hopes to make practical use of the experience he's gained.

Appointment of Margaret Ottenbreit (R) of 84 Fort Hale Road to the Fair Rent Commission

Ms. Ottenbreit said that her experience working with Livable City Initiative and as a landlord allows her to bring balance to the Commission.

Appointment of Christopher Shirley (G), P.O. Box 201682, Yale Station, to the Peace Commission.

Staff presented a letter from the administration requesting withdrawal, after Mr. Shirley said that he has a schedule conflict and would be unable to serve.

Appointment of Justin T. Bagnati (U), 157 Maple Street, to the Greater New Haven Transit District.
