The purpose of the workshop was to receive an overview of and have an initial discussion of the 2009-2010 Community Development Block Grant/Consolidated Plan process. Elizabeth Smith from Office of Management and Budget explained the application and review process for the agencies and departments. She distributed written materials, which are in the meeting file. She gave an overview of this year's proposed budget. She described the monitoring process. She went through and explained the various sections in the large book called the "Informational Package." The book includes info on all the agencies that applied the newspaper ads, and the agenda and sign-in sheets from the meetings held for the agencies. The package includes the Citizen Participation Plan, the Executive Summary, and the current Five-Year Plan, which is coming to an end.

There was a discussion of the circumstances under which two housing development corporations were not recommended for funding this year. Staff was asked to contact the Development Administrator to get information on this and also the issue concerning new construction versus rehab.
